Grape Variety: Nebbiolo

Region: Pyrenees, Victoria

Alcohol: 12.5%

Colour: Mid Salmon rose with an onion skin hue.

Nose: Lifted notes of red flowers, pomegranate, orange peel, jasmine and fresh stone fruits.

Palate: Fleshy mouth filling red fruit flavours combine with a citrus tang and a biscotti like nuttiness. The finish is creamy and dry.

Try it chilled on a warm day beside some moving water with a bunch of good people, or just that one special one. It also tastes great when served with tuna or salmon dishes. Best drunk within a few years of the vintage to enjoy its freshness and vitality.
